DEADLINE: 25 JANUARY 2019

You are invited to submit titles and abstracts for conventional oral presentations, speed talks, and posters at the 2019 Joint Conference of The Alberta Chapter and The Canadian Section of The Wildlife Society. Presentations on all aspects of wildlife are welcome including ecology, management, research, monitoring, species biology, genetics, and new techniques.

Indicate type of presentation: Traditional oral presentations will be **12 minutes** in length (plus 3 minutes for questions), speed talks are **4 minutes** in length. There will be a question period at the end of the speed talk session. Further guidelines for oral and poster presentations will be posted on the ACTWS and CSTWS websites.

The following information should be provided:

1. Type of presentation: Traditional oral presentation (12min), speed talk (4 min), poster
2. Lead author name, affiliation, mailing address, phone number(s), and e-mail address.
3. Names and affiliations of additional authors
4. Title of abstract
5. ABSTRACT: Distillation of the purpose, methods, results and conclusions, **250 words max**. (Please note that *all abstracts are printed in the program booklet*—the abstract you will submit will be the final that is printed in the program booklet).

Please note: An automated **confirmation email** should be received upon submission of the abstract. If you do not receive confirmation, or have other questions, please email abstracts@actws.ca. Authors will be advised of the final decision on their abstract by **15 February 2019**.
